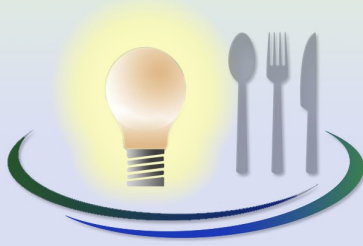

### **Biography**
